Speaking and writing about the major tourist destinations in Italy. Planning tourist itineraries in Italy.

MODULO 2: UK

Geography, political system and a brief history of the UK - Key moments in the 20th and 21st centuries – Around England: the coast, village life, industrial heritage, London - Around Wales, Scotland (Edinburgh and Glasgow, the Loch Ness mystery) and Ireland (Dublin, Belfast and The Troubles, Saint Patrick). Planning an itinerary. Describing the most important monuments and landmarks in the UK; making itineraries in the UK.

MODULO 3: USA

Geography, political system and a brief history of the USA - Key moments in the 20th and 21st centuries -Around the USA: the coast (California, Florida, Hawaii), national parks, Washington DC; other major cities (NY, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Las Vegas and Orlando) - Aspects of American society; The Hippies and the American music festivals of the past, Ellis Island, the Statue of Liberty; Racism. Planning an itinerary. Describing the most important monuments and landmarks in the USA; making itineraries in the USA
